

Daily Health Screening for COVID-19 for Anyone Entering the Colonial Baptist Building for HUDS Academy/HARC

This must be performed at home before leaving for class each time a student or staff is traveling to HUDS Academy/HARC.

- 1. Have you or anyone in your family had close contact (within 6 feet for at least 15 minutes) in the last 14 days with someone diagnosed with COVID-19, or has any health department or health care provider been in contact with you and advised you to quarantine?**

Yes > the individual should not be at the facility. The individual can return 14 days after the last time he or she had close contact with someone with COVID-19 or as listed below.

No > the individual may enter

- 2. Do you or anyone in the same family have these symptoms?**

Fever of 99.4 or greater

Chills

Shortness of Breath or difficulty breathing

New Cough or runny nose (even if allergies are suspected)

New loss of taste or smell

Diarrhea or vomiting

Yes > Go home and contact your health care provider

- 3. Since the last time at the facility, has anyone in the family been diagnosed with COVID-19?**

Yes > the individual must go home until they meet the criteria below.

For readmission all the criteria must be met:

Has it been at least 10 days since the symptoms first appeared?

Has it been at least 3 days since the person had a fever without using fever reducing medication?

Has it been at least 3 days since the person's symptoms have improved, including cough and shortness of breath?

Then a test is not needed

Testing:

An individual may enter if 10 days have passed since the date of the first positive test unless they develop symptoms after the positive test. Then go to the above criteria.

If a person has a negative test then it must be at least 24 hours since a fever with no medication and they feel well.

Contact:

If a person has been in close contact with someone diagnosed with COVID-19 they must quarantine for 14 days and have no symptoms or test positive.
